



# Application of Eligibility for ACOOG Distinguished Fellowship

To be considered eligible for the title of Distinguished Fellow, a candidate must meet the application criteria and accumulate a minimum of 35 points. It is the responsibility of the candidate to inform the ACOOG Office of points with proper documentation. Candidates must be approved by a three-fourths vote of the Distinguished Fellows. Voting Process: The Candidate must submit application, meet and document the minimum required points by June 1. Upon approval of the Distinguished Fellows by ballot vote, notification will be sent to you. This notice will include information to assist you with preparation and participation for the installation of the new Distinguished Fellows at the Annual Conference. A candidate must meet these preliminary requirements:

- 1. Certified by the AOA.**
- 2. Senior or Life member of the ACOOG in good standing for a minimum of five (5) years.**
- 3. Accumulation of thirty-five (35) points.**
- 4. Submit application fee of \$150.00, non-refundable.**
